#### The following are the thoughts of former Guild member Max Wellins

Wine is a curious stuff. Unlike commercial beer, baked beans, BHP shares, antiques or anything else that people drink, manufacture, invest in or collect, wine has a birth, a childhood, a maturity, a serenity and a death. It can be pretty or ugly, subtle or coarse, complex or obvious, brash or backward. It changes every year you keep it, every vintage, every few hundred yards of vineyard, every different grape variety, fruit, vegetable or flower from which it is made, every time a new winemaker makes wine (or every time an old winemaker tries new tricks!!), and every time a different food accompaniment emphasises a specific component of its taste. It beguiles, intoxicates, soothes, excites and relaxes. It can inflame the young lover, and provide solace for its grandfather; it can render conversation unnecessary, and yet seduce a normally non-dissertator into this kind of intemperate verbal excesses such as this paragraph. It is an essential ingredient of life, as complex as life and as varying as humanity.

We, of the Eltham and District Winemakers Guild, dedicate ourselves to producing wine, the understanding and appreciation of it.



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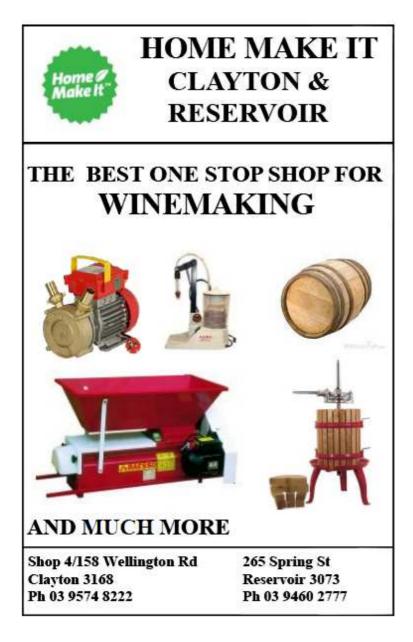
