One particular wine called Great Wall red would have only received the minimum points at our annual Wine Show. All wines tasted were thin, lacked fruit flavour and bore little resemblance to the claimed grape variety they were produced from. There will be no imminent threat to the Australian wine industry at this stage of China's fledgling industry. To their credit improvements will be rapid over the next ten years and China has a very diverse range of climate and soils to assist this development.


