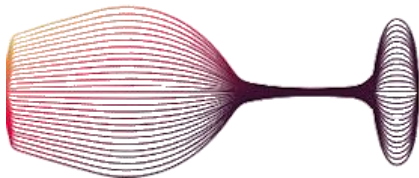


Introduction to Winemaking
