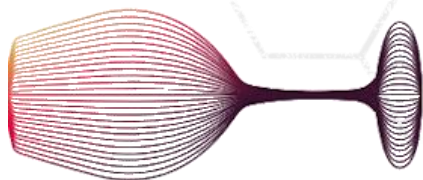


# Introduction to Meadmaking
